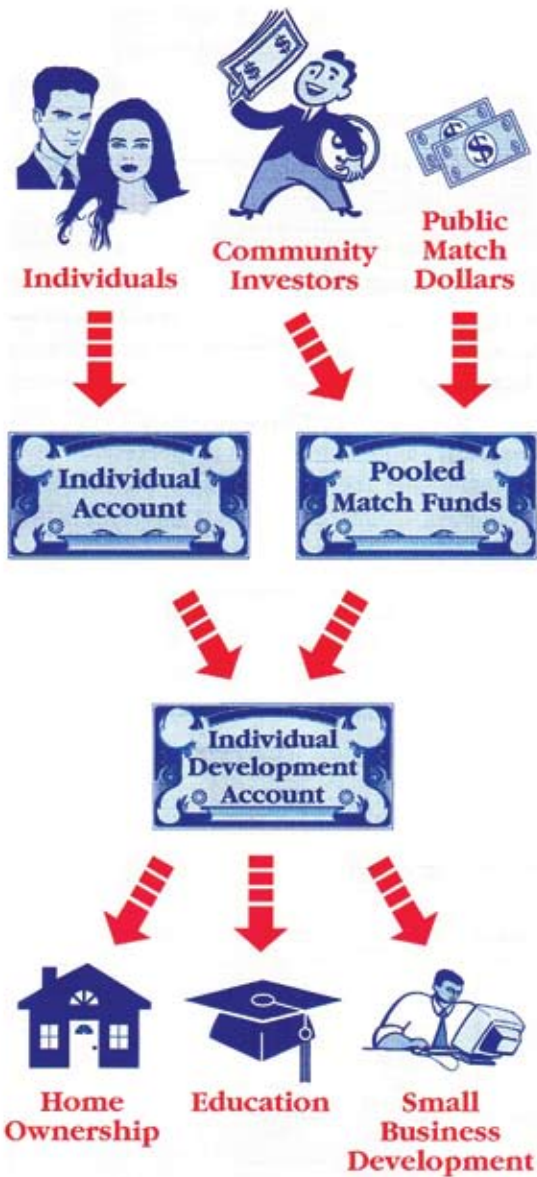

Saving for Us is a new matched savings program designed to help you save for and purchase your asset dream. Participants open special savings accounts, Individual Development Accounts (IDAs), and save \$30 or more each month. When they're ready to buy a house, launch a business, or go to school, their savings are matched

2 for 1

That's \$2 Dollars for Every \$1 Dollar You Save!

While you're saving you can strengthen your financial knowledge, sharpen your money management skills and repair your credit record in a ten part personal finance and money management workshop series.

WHAT ARE ASSETS?

An asset is something you own that will most likely increase in value, such as property, a business, or an education. It usually takes a considerable amount of time and money to build assets. With the help that the Saving for Us program can offer, you could reach your asset much sooner.

Homeownership
Starting your own business
Furthering your education

...these are the things that we can help you achieve. Not to mention, that you will be building financial knowledge and skill in the process.

Am I Eligible?

- 1) If you live in one of the 14 counties served by the UCHRA (*listed on the back of this brochure*).
- 2) If your family's adjusted gross income falls within the chart *on the right*. OR...
- 3) within Federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) limits at the time of application.
- 4) If you own less than \$10,000 in assets. Excluding your primary residence and one (1) vehicle.

If you said "YES" to all of these, then you would probably qualify.
